Elbit Systems of America, LLC, and the Logistic Center Woensdrecht (Netherlands Ministry of Defense) celebrated the signing of the partnership between the two organizations in a ceremony today at Volkel Airbase the Netherlands, officiated by the Netherlands Minister of Defense Jeanine Hennis-Plasschae. This partnership marks the official commencement of an agreement and work share cooperation intended to foster growth of the Logistic Center Woensdrecht and Elbit Systems of America and grow current support capability for the Royal Netherlands Air Force (RNLAf) and other countries.

The Elbit Systems of America and Logistic Center Woenstrecht partnership is focused on improving support of the RNLAf fleet as well as broadening regional Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) activities with other OEMs to support military and civilian aircraft in Europe.
