- Loitering munitions, laser and multi-mode seekers, and advanced targeting systems provide increased targeting accuracy and flexibility, minimizing collateral damage. Loitering munitions also provide soldiers with advanced surveillance and additional strike capabilities
- Small, lightweight, precision munition seekers and sensors are highly accurate against stationary and high-speed moving targets. Handheld target locators and designators aid laser-guided munitions and more.
- Troops can benefit from Elbit Systems of America's small and tactical unmanned aerial solutions. Payload size and duration of flight for the vehicles vary to fit the mission, providing an edge to the modern warfighter.

Increased aircraft mission availability and reduced operating cost:

- Elbit Systems of America provides Integrated Logistics Support and planning, Performance Based Logistics, Contractor Logistics Support and depot repairs for a variety of vertical flight and fixed-wing aircraft, including the AH-64 Apache.
